BREWERIES AND FOOD IN LARIMER COUNTY

If you love beer, you'll love Larimer County. While it's no Portland, it is known for its array of craft breweries. If you want to taste Colorado beer, plan to attend the Brewers Festival in June of each year in Fort Collins where you can sample 150+ Colorado beers.

The largest brewery in Larimer County is New Belgium Brewing Company, based in Fort Collins since its inception in 1991. The craft brewery is 100% employee-owned and makes the popular Fat Tire Belgian Style Ale. It's the fourth largest craft brewery in America and the 11th largest brewery in the United States. Anheuser Busch is the largest and oldest brewery in Fort Collins, and Coopersmith's Pub & Brewing and Odell Brewing tie for the longest-standing craft breweries—both opened their doors in 1989. The newest players on the market include Prost Brewing, Freedonia Brewing and Red Truck Beer in Fort Collins, and Dratz Brewing, Machination Mead Works and Laughing Leprechaun Meadery in Loveland.
